A Licensed Laboratory will be at the Depot Monday November 9th from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm to perform Covid-19 Tests. While the tests are free, the cost to administer the test is **\$12.50 per person payable** by check or cash at the time of testing, credit cards also at an additional fee. **Test results will be available within 15 minutes of testing.**

All residents are welcome and appointments are not necessary.
