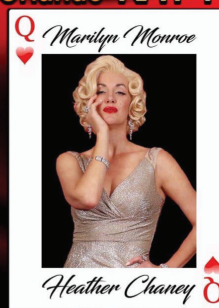

Even though we are planning for Thanksgiving, it isn't too soon to think of ideas to "dazzle" your neighborhood!

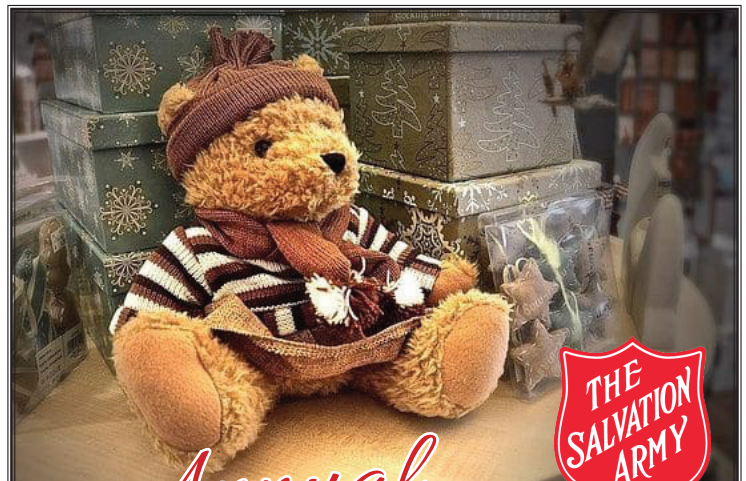
